The forum **objectives** are:

- 1- To get a long-term vision of the strategies and targets to which these technologies are moving (ten-year perspective).
- 2- To give the appropriate conditions to promote the direct contact between leading researchers and company managers, in order to find common interests and potential collaborations.

The Forum **structure** is as follows:

1- Morning:

Various **KEYNOTE SPEAKERS**, from international companies, will talk about the company’s point of view, its strategy vis-à-vis the technology evolution in the field and the actions to be taken as success warranties.

FENIN will present its innovation strategy, together with its services and support to companies.

CIBER-BBN will present its scientific priority lines, its technologies and projects in this area as well as its internal programs to promote collaborations between research groups and industry.

2- Afternoon:

A partnering session will be organized. In different one-to-one meetings, participants will share knowledge, skills, affinities and mutual interests between them. Hopefully, future collaborations can arise from these first interviews in further meetings.
