Barcelona is the center of the most dynamic bioregion in Southern Europe, Catalonia. According to the Biocat Directory 2017, the healthcare and life sciences sector is made up of 871 companies - including biotech, pharma, medtech and digital health companies - 41 research centers, 104 hospitals, 18 university hospitals with remarkable research activity, 12 universities offering life sciences degrees, 14 scientific and technology parks with life sciences activity and 3 large-scale scientific facilities like the ALBA Synchrotron, the Barcelona Supercomputing Center (BSC) and the National Center for Genome Analysis (CNAG). All these facts highlight that Catalonia is nowadays at the forefront in the development of a global knowledge-based economy and it will be in the forthcoming years.
