- Manage general laboratory services, including waste management and lab coat cleaning, to ensure a clean and safe working environment.
- Management of own space in animal facility.
- Support the Research Director in creating templates and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) as needed.

- Support in conducting some experimental in vitro, including developing protocols.
- Coordinating with other team members and following experiments timelines.
- Collect and analyse data as required.
