The Institute of Health Research Pere Virgili (IISPV, in Catalan) has a position for EU Outreach Officer to join the International Projects Unit team. Under the project "**GO_HERO (Health European Research Offices): A collaborative unit to promote internationalisation in the biomedical field**" (funded by the PERIS program), we are looking for a candidate to help us with the promotion of the research that takes place at the IISPV at international level. We would like to increase our visibility to the European Commission but also to other European platforms, international associations of patients and the pharmaceutical / biotech industry, as well as other similar research institutions.

The position would fit someone who wants to gain work experience in the promotion of research at international level. Through the analysis of the EU health priorities and the support of different communication tools (ex. web, social networks, participation in events, etc.), the candidate will help increase IISPV's reputation and international visibility. In addition, the candidate will manage the organisation of all the training activities for IISPV researchers under the GO_HERO objectives.

The IISPV coordinates all the health and biomedical research activity taking place in the regions of Tarragona and Terres de l'Ebre (Southern Catalonia). The IISPV was founded in 2005 under the collaborative agreement by the Catalan Institute of Health from Camp de Tarragona and Terres de l'Ebre, the SAGESSA Health Group, the Pere Mata Mental Health Institute and the University Rovira i Virgili (URV). The interdisciplinary and collaborative nature of IISPV's foundation, has remained our trademark among our scientific community to tackle the bottlenecks in health research in order to improve the quality of life of our community.

- Post-award management of IISPV's grant portfolio, including external audits.
- Point of contact for our research community, collaborators and funding organisations for queries regarding grants administration.
- Population and maintenance of IISPV's grant portfolio and research activities databases.
- Regular searches and analysis of key stakeholders activity to identify priorities aligned to IISPV's strategic lines.
- Support the coordination of activities for the new website and creation of the content in English.
