- The award winning company will receive an accrediting diploma which will endorse their viability as a successful project.

Selection and evaluation criteria

- Companies must develop their activity in Catalonia
- Be related to new developments on the field of diagnostics and medical technology or digital health.
- Companies established after January 1st, 2013.
- Companies with a well-defined entrepreneurial and support team.
- Capitalization of the company must be over 50.000€
- Applications must comply with the format requirements. Be readable, accessible and include all requested elements at the time of submission.
- Late submissions will not be accepted.

Remember that your 5 min pitch must include

- Market /medical need and market size (prevalence /incidence)
- Proposed solution
- Business Model
- Team, IPR and competitors
- Development Strategy and forecasts of break even
- Funding request and available investment tickets
