ISGlobal is looking for a research technician to join our young and dynamic team in child-health and air pollution research.

ISGlobal is offering a position of R+D Grants & Contracts Preaward Manager to cover a new position in one of our campuses.

Purpose and basic functions

To detect funding opportunities, to analyse and disseminate key information from calls for proposals and donors policies for global health projects and initiatives, according to the objectives of the strategic plan and needs of the organization.

To provide tailored advice and support on grant proposals preparations in liaison with ISGlobal staff (principal investigators, project managers, scientific coordinator, grant managers).

Specific Functions

- To identify and pro-actively disseminate calls for proposal from public and private institutions, specific for Global Health Projects and Initiatives as per ISGlobal research interests.
- To provide support during the process of application preparation:
 - Compliance of proposals to funder requirements,
 - Contractual procedures and obligations,
 - Forecast and control of deadlines.
 - Support in proposal writing & budgeting.
 - Proposal delivery; follow up on submitted applications.
- To coordinate formal acceptance of granted projects; liaise with the legal Dept, grant managers and HHRR Dept (when appropriate) the negotiation phase of research-related contracts, such as grants agreements, subgrants, subcontracts, fellowships.
- Management of internal and external signatures in a multi-institutional environment.

- Maintenance of grants & contracts databases for accurate activity reports.
- Any other duties related to the post as requested by superiors; to contribute to the general functioning of the Grants Office.

Skills and competencies

- Proven ability to prioritize, work with deadlines and under pressure.
- Organized, high attention to detail; ability to summarize and communicate key information at all levels.
- Proactive attitude to identify the needs of the principal investigators and the organization.
- Ability to work independently and in a team in an international multicultural environment.

Education

- University degree; preferably but not necessarily in Life Science.
- Advanced level of English, spoken and written, a must

Experience, technical skills

- Minimum 3 years experience of preaward management in a similar position.
- Knowledge and experience managing calls from European and International funders (such as H2020, EDCTP, EIT Health, NIH) is required.
- Knowledge and experience managing calls from Spanish/Catalan national funders (Spanish Ministry of Science, ISCIII, AGAUR, PERIS) will be valued but is not required.
- Experience working in a research centre will be valued.

Salary and conditions

- Full-time position 2 years.
- Compensation will be based on the internal scales and applicant's experience and qualifications.

For what purpose do we process your personal data?
