The candidate will join a multidisciplinary research group with wide expertise in clinical and translational research in the field of viral hepatitis and immune-mediated liver diseases. Our main lines of research are the study of HBV and HDV replication biomarkers for monitoring disease progression and response to anti-viral therapy, and the identification of host (immune) factors to predict patient outcome and treatment response in both autoimmune and viral hepatitis.

What we need:

- PhD in biomedicine, biology, biotechnology, or related sciences.
- Proven experience in molecular biology, virology and/or immunology research.
- Understanding of omics data and biological processes.
- Good communication skills in English, both spoken and written.
- Highly motivated and team-oriented person.
- Ability to work independently and with initiative to propose and develop new scientific ideas.
