### **Description:**

ISGlobal is looking for part-time (60%) coordinator for the Neosonic Project, based in Morocco (Rabat) and funded by AECID. He/she will be responsible of project success implementation through conducting several actions in the field of health, training activities, public awareness and capacity building.

NEOSONIC is an innovative project that aims to provide a more efficient and less invasive screening methodology for neonatal and infant meningitis.
